But, the question on most employers' minds is, "how are these new overtime rules going to affect our business and our employees?" Employers will face several challenges in implementing the DOL's new overtime regulations, so it is vital to begin the process with all of the facts. For example, the new overtime regulations: More than double the federal minimum salary for "white collar" exemptions to \$47,476 annually (\$913 per week) Increase the total annual compensation level for highly-compensated employees (HCE) to \$134,004 (up from \$100,000 annually) Set automatic increases to the minimum salary and HCE compensation levels every three years (beginning January 1, 2020) Make up to 4.2 million salaried employees eligible for overtime Apply to virtually all businesses, non-profit organizations, and municipal governments and agencies Learn from our panel of experts as they discuss what you, as an employee, need to do now to ensure compliance with the new overtime regulations by the effective date of December 1, 2016.
